



The Dr Hugh Hall Young Carers' Scholarship Scholarship Guidelines 2026

This is the second year we are awarding this scholarship, which is kindly funded by our former Principal, Dr Hugh Hall to provide extra financial support while you study to help you become more independent and give you a boost. It is aimed at encouraging you to treat yourself, to promote your health and well-being and to make your life a little bit easier in between caring, working and studying.

Who Can Apply?

Full or part-time students at Fife College who are young carers (aged up to 26 years old). A young carer is someone who cares, unpaid, for a family member, friend or member of your community, regularly and on a long-term basis.

What Do You Receive if Successful?

We have a generous £2,000 available this year to be shared with successful applicants, at the discretion of our panel.

Being recognised for this award is also a great achievement and would look good on your CV boosting your further study and employment prospects.

What Can You Spend the Scholarship On?

This scholarship is to help you with the things you need to support you during your studies such as a new laptop, travel expenses, books, equipment, software, or other resources. It can also be used for things to help you look after yourself and progress, such as days out, gym membership, clothes or driving lessons.
