

## **Fife College and Edinburgh Napier University Associate Student Scholarship**

### **APPLICATION GUIDELINES**

Fife College and Edinburgh Napier University are committed to widening opportunities for all. Both organisations have therefore launched this scholarship to give financial support to Fife College students as they begin their degree journey at Fife College before progressing to Edinburgh Napier University to complete their degree.

This is a unique partnership, and Fife College is delighted to be able to offer this support through its scholarship programme – Adam Smith Scholarships.



#### **Who Can Apply?**

Full-time students currently at Fife College studying HNC or HND (year one or year two) from August 2023 on:

- HNC Electrical Engineering
- HNC/D Quantity Surveying
- HNC/D Computing: Software Development
- HNC/D Cyber Security

Students should be committed to their studies and to an engineering, surveying or computing career, with the aim of articulating to **Edinburgh Napier University to study for a degree. Students also need to be an Associate Student of Edinburgh Napier University to apply for a Scholarship.** Further details about the Associate Student Scheme are available from your college lecturer or email [degrees@fife.ac.uk](mailto:degrees@fife.ac.uk)

#### **What Do You Receive if Successful?**

If successful you will be awarded **£1,000 each year**, for up to a maximum of 4 years, to support you with your studies. The awards will be made annually while you remain on the Associate Student Programme and continue to study at either Fife College or Edinburgh Napier University. Payments will be made between January and April in year one, to allow time for matriculation, and then in subsequent years at the start of each academic year. (Please note, you will not receive payment for any years you are required to repeat).

#### **What Can You Spend the Scholarship On?**

The scholarship should be used for resources or materials that will help you with your studies such as a laptop, software, tools or equipment. Once at university the award should be used to support travel, accommodation, books and other expenses linked to studying at university.

#### **How to Apply**

A link to the application form is available on the Fife College website in the Scholarship section – if you require a hard copy form please get in touch. Please remember to explain clearly on the personal statement section why you should be considered for a Fife College and Edinburgh Napier Scholarship award.

## What Happens Next?

**References** We may ask a staff member who knows you for a reference.

**Presentation** This is where you receive your scholarship and a certificate.

# Annual Award thanks to University Partnership

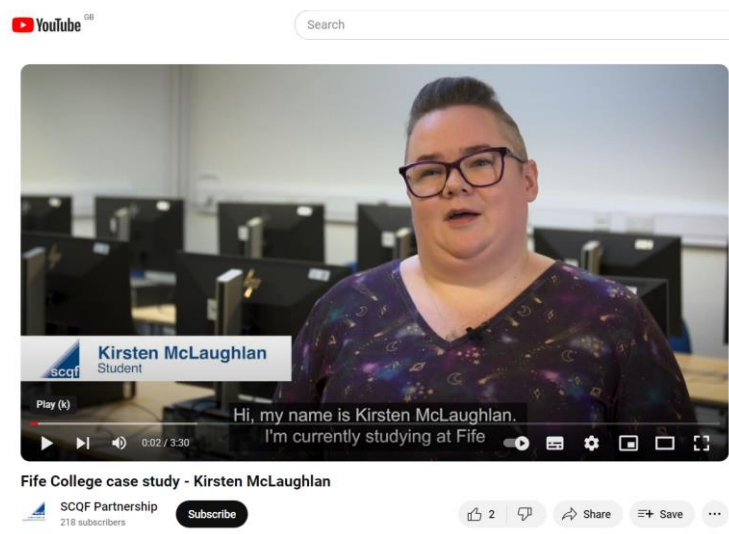
