- Computer card games Design and create your own computer game by playing and exploring some existing card games. Flesh out your idea with graphics, pictures and descriptions, then pitch your idea to your peers. Only the best idea will win!
- Games creation with GDevelop -Create your twist on the classic computer platformer (like Mario) and design your own character, level, and gameplay settings. Then use GDevelop - the fastest, easiest, most powerful no-code game engine - to create your game.
- Esports Compete against your friends in some gaming fun! In this workshop you will learn the rules and details of a game, come up with a format and rules for a tournament, split into teams, compete, and commentate!
- 3D technology Use cutting edge 3D scanning technology to capture a 3D model of real-life objects. Learn how these can be edited using 3D computer modelling and animation software and then printed using 3D printers. Explore how this technology is being used within the manufacturing, film and computer games industry.
